Who We Are:

The Original GTO Club of Milwaukee, Wisconsin is a non-profit organization whose members have a passion for classic Pontiacs. General Information:

The Original GTO Club of Milwaukee, Wisconsin was founded in 1978 and was originally an international organization before the GTOAA was in existence. The club started small and has seen its membership fluctuate over the years as do many such organizations. As for 2011, the club has around 50 members, nearly all of whom live in southeastern Wisconsin. The club has a corporate structure with a board of directors, four officers and a complete set of bylaws through which club business is governed.

Meetings and Club Events:

Our club sponsors about 6 events each year. As expected, they pretty much center on driving our Pontiacs to a car-themed location or gathering. **Our signature event is the All-Pontiac car show we co-host with EJ Salentine Buick-Pontiac in Muskego.** In 2010, we hosted 139 Pontiacs and raised over \$1,000 from this show for the MACC Fund (Milwaukee Athletes Against Childhood Cancer.) Other club events include driving to Wisconsin car museums and automobile displays, cruises to local drive-ins like Gus's in East Troy, and a Fall Cruise through the scenic Wisconsin countryside.

We no longer hold club meetings by themselves, but rather, meetings are held in conjunction with the events noted above.

The Redline:

The Redline is our club newsletter where we report meeting minutes, club finances, and learn about each other's Pontiacs and why they are special to us. It's delivered quarterly, typically a few weeks before a club event. While the Redline is our mainstay of club communications, our club officers and board hold regular conference calls to discuss club issues and events, regular E-mails are sent out to all club members with fun Pontiac facts and club announcements, and any club member can call any officer for information or input any time.
