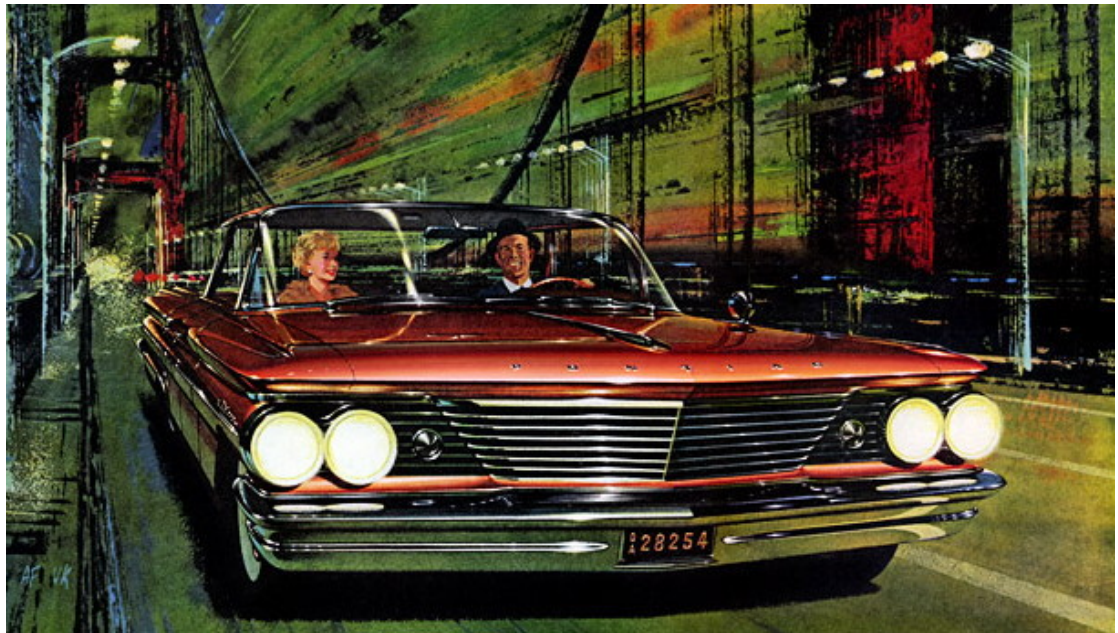

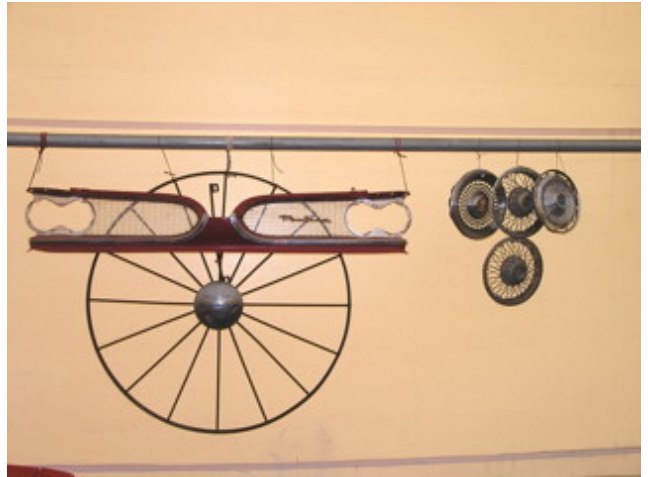

Recap of the 30th All-Pontiac Car Show!

Good weather again graced us at our 30th All-Pontiac Car Show at EJ Salentine Buick in Muskego. This is our 4th year at this venue and while we had a relatively low turnout (only 107 Pontiacs) we garnered our highest proceeds this year. After satisfying show-related expenses, we cleared \$1,765! Our club officers decided to split the donations as follows:

- \$,1400 to the MACC Fund
- \$ 400 to the Muskego Food Pantry

To all who helped with the show or attended, a big THANKS from your club officers. That's a righteous contribution to help kids with cancer and hungry folks as well.

A few observations about this year's show:

1. This is the first year we have used a new fee structure for the show: \$10 for pre-registration and \$15 day-of-show (no doubt helped increase the gate.)
2. We combined some GTOs this year into a single class: GTOs 64 – 67. In addition, we made a few other class changes as well and ended up with 17 classes. We gave out 48 awards.
3. We had 25 pre-registrations, the most in the last four years.
4. We sold \$310 in Raffle tickets and a good number of shirts as well.
5. We are considering moving the show out one week (think August 21) to avoid competing with the end of State Fair and the Waukesha Old Car Club's mega show.
